While this isn't actually a physical place to visit, it's worth putting your paws together for Jim and Julie Dugan. This Tacoma couple formed the Dugan Foundation to help support no-kill companion animal facilities in Pierce County. The foundation alternates between two large biannual fundraising events—Woofstock, a music and adoption fest, and the black tie Fur Ball.

These two events raise money the foundation then grants to places such as shelters, clinics and rescue organizations for projects that help support a no-kill community. The foundation also hosts a variety of adoption programs to help increase adoptions of pets into good homes.

As if that weren't enough, the organization is also in the final design stages of The Sanctuary, a facility that will act as a halfway house for animals that come into shelters but are not ready for adoption, whether it be due to abuse, illness or other special need.
